



Noise Reduction

Reduce the background noise of the other party.

When the area around the other party is noisy and it is difficult to hear, you can reduce the surrounding noise to make the person's voice easier to hear.

Talking Caller ID

Identify the caller without looking at the handset

The handset notifies you of caller information with a voice, so that you know who is calling without having to go to the base unit to view the display. This is convenient because you can predict who should answer the phone.
